We look forward to the participation of both authors of presentations and posters, participants in discussions, and listeners interested in the current picture of archaeology in Silesia. We would also like to invite those of you who, for various reasons, cannot share presentations at the conference. We hope the desire to meet and discuss more or less officially will be sufficient reason to come to Sobótka.

We encourage all participants on Saturday (28.09.) to take part in an archaeological and natural history tour of Sobótka and the surrounding area, during which it will be possible to see sites and objects generally inaccessible to visitors.
